

Schedule of Personal Contact Programme (PCP) for Post Qualification Course in International Trade Laws & WTO

In terms of the requirements of Para 10 of the Notification No. 1-CA (7)/64A/2003 in Part III Section 4 of the Gazette of India (Extraordinary) dated 4.12.2003 for the Post Qualification Course in International Trade Laws and World Trade Organisation, Part I of the Course is to be supported by Personal Contact Programmes (PCPs) for a minimum duration of 30 days covering the subject matter of all the Papers contained in Part I of the Course. The record of attendance in the Personal Contact Programme (with a minimum attendance record of 80%) is also required to be produced at the time of applying for admission to the examination for the Course.

In view of the above, the 30 days Personal Contact Programme (PCPs) covering the syllabus for all the six papers of the Course, is organized in two phases of 15 days each twice in a year at **New Delhi** as follows: -

For candidates willing to be eligible to appear in ITL& WTO Course Examination Part I to be held in May each year	PCP's are held in two phases of 15 days each during December (of the previous year) & January (of that year)
For candidates willing to be eligible to appear in ITL& WTO Course Examination Part I to be held in November each year	PCP's are held in two phases of 15 days each during June & August (of that year)

1st Phase would cover syllabus of:-

Paper I: Introduction to International Trade

Paper II: GATT, Rules of Origin and Trade Related Agreements

Paper III: GATS, TRIPS and TRIMS, SPS and Dispute Settlement and Review Procedures in WTO

2nd Phase would cover syllabus of:-

Paper IV: Domestic Trade Laws

Paper V: Anti-dumping, Anti-subsidy and Safeguard - Laws and Practice

Paper VI: Competition Laws and Policies

The exact date wise schedule and venue of the PCP's is announced separately in due course. The presentations made by the faculties during the Ist batch of PCP's are available at the website for reference purposes.

As you would be aware, the fee structure of the Post Qualification Course in International Trade Laws & WTO has been modified as follows: -

“Registration fee

Rs. 20,000/- (or its equivalent in foreign currency) payable in two installments: -

- **1st Installment of Rs. 10,000/- payable at the time of Registration for Part I of the Course**
- **2nd Installment of Rs. 10,000/- payable at the time of applying to attend the Personal Contact Programme for the Course.”**

Accordingly, Candidates who wish to attend above said PCPs and have not yet paid the fee towards 2nd installment for the Course are requested to send the fee of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) towards 2nd installment for the Post Qualification Course in International Trade Laws & WTO which can be paid only through a Demand Draft or Pay Order, drawn in favour of "The Secretary, The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India", payable at New Delhi in the duly filled up enclosed form atleast 15 days prior to the start of the PCPs at the following address:-
